lecture	Legal conditions of doing business in Poland: Act – Entrepreneurs' Law. Act on Central Register and Information on Economic Activity and Information Point for Entrepreneurs. Act on Ombudsman for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises. Act on the Principles of Participation of Foreign Entrepreneurs and Other Foreign Persons in Business in the Territory of the Republic of Poland. Economic activity as part of business law. Guiding principles of business law. Concept of entrepreneur, categories of entrepreneurs in business law. Company - concept, protection of the right to a company. Forms of Business - sole proprietorship; partnership; commercial partnerships and corporations; state-owned enterprises. Procedure on registering a business; registration of a commercial partnership; registration of a sole proprietorship and a partnership; detailed steps of setting up a business. Financial support for micro, small and medium-sized entrepreneurs. Forms of taxation of "small business". Contracts in business; rules for entering into commercial contracts; general terms and conditions of contracts; types of commercial contracts. Basic rules for providing services in electronic form.
